

Questions and concerns about the you-know-whats are on the rise, and although the establishment would like us to think the critics are cranks, it's getting harder and harder for them to make that claim.

A relatively new one is David Gortler, who served as senior adviser to the FDA commissioner.

Here's how the Yale Medical School website describes Gortler and his appointment:

David Gortler, PharmD, was four years into teaching pharmacology at Yale School of Medicine (YSM) when he was first approached by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Officials from the agency invited him to present his research in Washington, D.C. It wasn't long before he was on the FDA's staff as a medical officer evaluating new drugs for approval.

Gortler recently completed a second tour on the FDA's executive leadership team as the first and only pharmacist/pharmacologist ever appointed senior advisor to the FDA commissioner. He served as an expert in drug safety, FDA regulatory affairs, and science policy. "It was a dynamic and high-pressure role, especially as we helped see through the emergency authorization of two novel mRNA vaccines to treat COVID-19," Gortler said.

And now here are a few brief excerpts from remarks Gortler just delivered:

I was working as the senior advisor to the FDA Commissioner on Drug Safety and FDA science policy. I was fired by the administration and my position was never replaced. In fact, the FDA commissioner's position was not replaced for an entire year....

I don't understand how my physician colleagues and especially my pharmacist colleagues who are working and giving this vaccine are still continuing to do so when they don't know anything about it....

It should be updated to reflect the lack of safety, the lack of efficacy, and specifically there need to be warnings about myocarditis, and others will speak of the same....

People don't know: what's the number of cells that are in these vaccines? Nobody knows. What's the half life? Nobody knows. I don't understand how in good conscience we can still be giving these vaccines at this point for the COVID-19, named after 2019, for a strain...that no longer exists.

These seem like legitimate questions from an obviously mainstream source. Much of the medical world has been intimidated into silence on the whole thing, as you well know, and that's why it's so important and significant when people like Gortler break ranks.
